The workshops will be led by distinguished educators who will apply their vast classroom experience to addressing relevant aspects of this new curriculum.




Delegates may find it useful to bring a laptop computer, and will receive a wealth of interactive resources along with free personal copy of the new *Autograph 3.3.*
